




Practicing our drawing activities according to the Teacher Guide.

## Feedback from our Teacher Trainings

### Suggestions to improve the Picture Dictionary:

“More topics would be good.”

“It would be good if there is a topic on: Flowers.”

“Add more vocabularies would be great.”

“Add some poems at the end of the book.”

“Add more topics would be great.”

“Making sentences options would be good for a little bit senior students.”

“Include more cultural activities, add some short stories would be great.”

“It would be good if there is some poems at the end of the book.”

“If there is some short stories for students it would be good.”

“It will be good if there is more vocabularies.”

“Sentence making and more vocabularies would be better.”

“If there is some more topics, It would be good.”

“At the end of the book if there is some motivational stories, it would be good.”

“Add some rhyme at the end of the book would be great.”

### Activity suggestions for the Teacher Guide:

“Drawing competition. Because there are so many cartoons which are related with our culture. So, students will happy to drawing own culture activities.”

“Activity name: Magic Box

In the class all students will sit in circle. In the box, according to students there will be enough pieces of paper for each student to write various types of activities on it, like: Say the Alphabet, Sing a song, Dance, etc. Every student will draw a piece of paper from the box and represent him in front of class what he has found on the paper.”

“Activity name: Crazy Train

Students can be grouped into 10-15. They are asked to lineup and connect among themselves to represent a train. Teacher says start when the train slowly forward. Teacher would then give command during the journey such as: fast, slow, move backwards, turn left, turn right and more. Students would listen to the teacher commands and make change to their move.”

“Do culture activities weekly or monthly.”

## What's Next:


### Book Distribution

- With 30 teachers completing our training, we will provide at least 750 more picture dictionaries
- We will provide notebooks and pens for every student and teacher.
